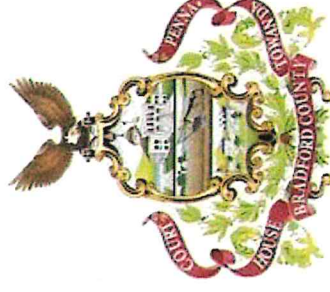


# 2025 CDBG



## Income Requirements

Extreme Low Income	\$18,250	\$20,850	\$23,450	\$26,050	\$28,150	\$30,250

- These income limits are determined using the CDBG HUD Guidelines, available at online at the HUD Exchange.
- HUD sets the average median income (AMI) for one person at \$60,840.
- Income categories are based on percentages of the AMI: Moderate income (80%), Low income (60%), Very low income (50%), and Extremely low income (30% or less).
- The CDBG program is designed to assist homeowners who fall within these income categories.
